THE DEACON: CALLED TO SERVE.

On Sunday 17 June at 3pm in St Michael's Enniskillen, Martin Donnelly of Enniskillen will be ordained as the first permanent deacon in our diocese since the diaconate was re-introduced by Vatican II as a 'distinct ministry of service'. All are welcome to witness Martin's ordination. On Monday 18 June, Deacon Martin will preside at Evening Prayer of Thanksgiving in St Michael's Church at 7.30pm. We are all asked to pray for Martin, his wife and family and the whole parish community of Enniskillen during the days ahead.

TRAINING TO BE A DEACON


The admission process for a deacon is similar to that for a priest. After a preparatory year, those candidates considered suitable and are accepted must begin a three-year formation programme, with classes held mostly at weekends. This is a substantial commitment to the study of Scripture, Theology, Liturgy and Canon Law. The rich tradition of Christian spirituality will be a key part of the formation period. Other aspects will include the development of personal and pastoral skills, including a pastoral placement for a time in the diocese.

What is a Celebret ? (A note from the Parish Priest).

To ensure that any Priest is a legitimate member of a Diocese / Order he must carry with him a "celebret" which is proof of his identity and good standing. Every Priest is obliged to present his "celebret" to the local Parish Priest, before he fulfils any priestly function, outside his own area. This necessity has been in place throughout Ireland and the worldwide Catholic Church for the past many years. All Priests know of this obligation and should have little difficulty in adhering to the request. In my own case, I recently had to provide my "celebret" to be allowed concelebrate at a Funeral Mass in a parish where I was not known by local clergy.

This is normal practise throughout Ireland and afar.
