The Future of Parish Life and Administration.

Recent letters from the Diocesan / Bishop's Office have reminded us about the pressure being experienced by Priests and Laypeople throughout our Parishes at this time. These letters have reminded us about the lessening number of Priests available to the Diocese and the resulting problems now and in the near future. We have also been reminded about the importance and necessity of the involvement of Laypeople in Parish activity so that the Priest can concentrate on spiritual / sacramental activity.

Many Parishioners discuss and speak about this this need and these activities but we hope that such discussion would turn into actual activity. In days gone by, the number of available clergy in all Parishes allowed for very little contribution by Laypeople but as the years passed by, this greatly changed. Do you remember a time when Special Ministers of the Eucharist did not exist? Do you remember a time when lay readers of the Scriptures did not exist? Do you remember a time when Parish Councils / Pastoral Groups did not exist? All this was due to the fact that each parish had sufficient Priests to carry out these roles and laypeople were not necessarily involved.

As days and years passed by, lay participation in Parish life grew and increased, for many different reasons. One reason may have been the Second Vatican Council which recommended lay participation in Parish life while the ongoing lessening in the number of clergy certainly played it's part in a greater lay contribution to Church life.

In a recent interview on local radio, Gary Carville (media representative of the Clogher Diocesan Office) complimented Magh Ene Parish as being very futuristic in it's presentation of Church life. We were commended for our use of Prayer Services where Mass was not possible and for the number of laypeople who organised and arranged many different Church activities in our Parish. We were recommended as an example to contemplate.

Although we have indeed reached a very good point in our presentation of Church and Sacramental life in our Parish, we need to ask ourselves how much we can individually contribute from our personal talents, so that the parish can continue to grow in a special way into the future. Without the understanding and generosity of all parishioners, every Parish will find it's future difficult. Therefore, we ask all those who wish to express their Faith in a meaningful way to consider the ways in which they can help our Parish grow. This may be in a small way initially but as time goes by, the interest and confidence generally grows.

This could be in the simple form of helping with a cake sale / joining one of our three choirs / helping with collections at Mass / being a Church Reader / helping with the Sacristy / being part of the Altar Society and many other areas of interest and help.

Don't be afraid to express your faith in action.
