# Diocesan Changes in Mass Times etc.

While the Parish of Magh Ene will not be affected by any changes in the coming year, this does not mean that some change will not be necessary in days to come. There is no doubt that the decreasing number of available clergy and the increasing age of present clergy will have an effect on their availability in the times ahead. Death, retirement, sickness and holiday / rest time will always place pressure on the present number of clergy and their local contribution. It is very important to realise that **simple replacement** of clergy is no longer possible and where a Priest becomes **unavailable**, it will be the obligation of the local laity to make a significant contribution to his loss and activity. It can **no longer** be a presumption that another Priest will immediately arrive to take his place

Parishes must, at this time, prepare for such situations in days to come by creating sub-committees which are able to function by themselves and not necessarily need the presence of the Priest. Pastoral groups, Altar Societies, Choirs, Ministers of the Eucharist, Church Readers, Cemetery Groups etc. need to control and direct their own activities. This will ensure that many of the parish activities are well organised and allow the Priest to carry out the spiritual work for which he was ordained and leave him the time to deal with events which give very little advance warning such as funerals, sick-calls, etc. In days to come, such Priests will be dealing with more than one parish and will need that extra time.

By parishes working in this manner, the Priest is also allowed to fulfil other spiritual obligations such as the visitation of schools, hospitals etc. It is very important to realise that every Priest fulfils many spiritual obligations very few Parishioners know about, because the Parishioners are not part of this specific need and generally do not know how the Priest spends his time.

When Parishes act in this way, Parishioners will discover a greater understanding of what essential parish life is all about and their own faith will grow to a greater degree. There is also the great possibility that adult members of families will then introduce their younger members to the work of the Parish in areas where they also can make a suitable contribution. This will be a very good spiritual education for them to remember as they ultimately become adults.

Therefore, the present pressure being felt by our Diocese and all it's Parishes needs to be understood and local attempts made to deal with it. The major answer is for a greater contribution by all age-groups within all Parishes. This will allow us to understand and prepare for any future pressures within our Parishes because there is no doubt that they will come among us. Anticipation and preparation is the only way of dealing with the future. Let us not be afraid to do so.
