Due to having only ONE Priest in the Parish for the foreseeable future, please note the following so that the administrative workload can be lessened, to some extent. The Parish will operate on a single diary. Please book occasions as early as possible. The 2018 Diary is now available and open to such bookings.

<u>Wednesday morning Masses</u> (unless on the day of a funeral) will take place in St. Joseph's Church, The Rock, Ballyshannon. Prayer services will be held in Bundoran on Wednesday mornings and in St. Joseph's Church on other days.

<u>When booking an anniversary Mass</u>, write the intended date of Mass and the name & address of the deceased on an envelope including the mass stipend. Leave in the Rock Sacristy or Parish Office. <u>Funeral Masses</u> should be arranged with the PRIEST to ensure he is available before any other arrangements are made. This is especially so at weekends.

<u>Church Envelopes / Donations</u>. From January 2018, ALL contributions to collections will be presumed to facilitate ongoing Church needs and debts. Both Parish Churches are in need of support in the days to come so that their maintenance can be given due attention.

<u>The exterior work on Bundoran Church</u> is progressing well and evidence within the walls indicate many decades of significant dampness. Work will begin on St. Joseph's at the Rock in January.

We are presently arranging the Parish Envelope List for 2018. If you have not been using the Parish Envelope System in the past and would like to do so in the future, please leave your name and address in the Sacristy or Parish Office before the end of November so that you can be added to the new listings. The recent request to update information on the cemetery maps (available on irishgraveyards.ie) only yielded two additional pieces of information so we hope to have the finalised maps in place by mid January.

Christmas Time.

Christmas Day falls on Monday this year, thereby causing some extra liturgical pressure on clergy and churches, because all will take place at one weekend. This timing presumes **eight Masses** in our two Churches on the Sat night, Sun morning, Sun evening and Monday morning. We will do our best to provide what is necessary but all will depend on the kindness of visiting clergy. The week beginning December 11th. will include extra Masses in our three care-homes and almost forty First Friday calls.

The Advent Wreath - It's Symbolism.

The symbolism of the Advent wreath is beautiful. The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning and no end, is used to symbolize the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul and eternal life. The wreath is made from various evergreens, signifying continuous life. The four candles, three purple/violet and one rose/pink represent the four weeks of Advent, one is lit on each of the four Sundays. Each candle represents a 1,000 years and added together they symbolize the 4,000 years, from Adam and Eve to the birth of Christ, the years that humanity waited for the Saviour. The light signifies Christ, the Light of the World.. Each of the four candles on an Advent wreath has their own meaning.

The first Sunday of Advent symbolizes Hope with the lighting of the first purple candle, the Prophet's Candle reminding us of the prophecy of the Old Testament that Jesus is coming.
