Ash Wednesday / Lent - A Very Old Tradition.

It was wonderful to see how many Parishioners and Visitors attended the Masses on Ash Wednesday. The reception and wearing of ashes is a very old tradition which is obviously very important to many people. The very common practise of bringing ashes to those who are confined to home or otherwise unable to attend the Church is a very commendable exercise and the number who did so was even greater than last year. We are learning from year to year.

It was explained at weekend Masses that it was not necessary for a Priest to bring and administer the ashes. A neighbour, family member or friend can fulfil the need for those unable to attend the Church. So, we thank those who showed such initiative in bringing the ashes to the sick, the retired and the house-bound. This showed our Christian faith in action and was a sign of modern Church practise.

In these days of a lessening number of Priests, the practise of talking ashes to the housebound is indicative of how the future needs of the Church will be fulfilled. Allowing the Priest to concentrate on the activity for which he was ordained will be even more important in the near future. The sharing of Parochial duties which can easily be undertaken by laity will obviously need to supplement the work of the Priest. When we realise that the practise of bringing the blessed ashes or Holy Communion to those who cannot attend Church and the Presentation of Prayer Services when Mass cannot be celebrated are commonplace nowadays, we should understand that Parish life is slowly changing and we are part of that change. For some Parishioners, this will be difficult to understand but future Parish life will completely depend on such generosity and participation in parish life.

Thanks to all who arranged and took part in the Friday Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration began at 10.30am and continued uninterrupted until 7pm. At all times, the Blessed Sacrament was attended and the Pastoral Centre was warm and inviting. The presentation of the area was pleasant with floral arrangements and prayer sheets / books available. The same times of adoration will take place next Friday but **NOT** on the following Friday, St Patrick's Day. The attendance list for those wishing to add their names for particular hours is available in the Church. Perhaps you might have time to spend an hour with the Lord.


Map of Finner Cemetery on display in Church Hallway. Please inform Parish Office of any changes before end of February.
