The week beginning Dec 11th. was given over to Sacramental Calls to the Sick and Housebound (approximately forty). Four Funeral Masses in our Churches during the past days greatly affected the above calls. Hopefully those throughout the Parish who did not receive a sacramental visit before Christmas will do so in the days after.

The Advent Wreath - It's Symbolism.

The symbolism of the Advent wreath is beautiful. The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning and no end, is used to symbolize the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul and eternal life. The wreath is made from various evergreens, signifying continuous life. The four candles, three purple/violet and one rose/pink represent the four weeks of Advent, one is lit on each of the four Sundays. Each candle represents a 1,000 years and added together they symbolize the 4,000 years, from Adam and Eve to the birth of Christ, the years that humanity waited for the Saviour. The light signifies Christ, the Light of the World..

Each of the four candles on an Advent wreath has their own meaning.

The Fourth Sunday of Advent symbolizes Peace with the lighting of the third purple candle, the Angel's Candle reminding us of the message of the angels:

"Peace on Earth, Good Will towards all people".
