Ordination of a new Priest for the Diocese of Clogher.

On Sunday 30 June next, Deacon Kevin Connolly from the parish of Donagh, Co Monaghan, will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Larry Duffy in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan, beginning at 3pm. Deacon Kevin is extending an open invitation to all to attend and participate in the ordination liturgy in the Cathedral on that day. On the following day, Monday 1 July, he will celebrate his first Mass in St Mary's Church, Glennan, Glaslough, Co Monaghan at 7pm. Once again, everyone will be welcome. The ordination of a priest is a great event in the life of the diocese and for the parish community. As a diocese, we give thanks to God for the gift of priesthood itself and, especially, that Deacon Kevin has answered "Yes" to God's call to serve the people of God in our diocese. We pray that others will do likewise, so that, through priesthood, the diaconate, religious life and other ministries, they may build up the community of faith that is the Church and be witnesses to Christ in the world. This ordination liturgy will also be historic in that Deacon Kevin will be the first priest to be ordained by Bishop Larry Duffy.

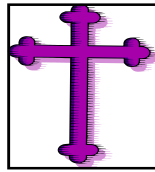
Parish History.

Many thanks to all who have shared church-related photographs etc. with the Parish Office in preparation for a possible "History of Parish Faith" at some time in the future. Approximately fifty such photographs have been copied and **the originals can be obtained from the Parish Office at any time.** We will spend the remainder of this year collecting suitable reminders of past Church activity and then consider putting it into book form in 2020 or 2021. The work of collection and the putting together of relevant information is a very time-consuming activity and because it is an extra activity in Parish life, the final result will always take longer than anticipated. The earliest photograph we have is from 1885 and the earliest document from approx. 1890. We recently discovered two books of signatures from **1910 - 1947 and 1947 - 1970** of priests who celebrated Mass in Bundoran Church at a time when con-celebration of Mass was not allowed. These signatures include Bishops and Priests from most countries in the world who came to visit Bundoran and celebrated Mass in our Church - such was the reason behind the number of altars which existed in the Church in days gone by. Some present parishioners will remember being altar-boys at that time and serving the many priests who came to our Church at that time. **Any more PHOTOGRAPHS will be welcome.**
