Financial Administration in Parish Life:

Auditors associated with the Diocese of Clogher request that all public collections be administered by at least two volunteers who will **"bag and tag" the income**. This presumes that the collections will be publicly placed in a special bag, a numbered tag inserted therein and the names of the supervisors' names written into an accompanying book. This is then **verified** by those who count the collection and prepare the amount for banking. We therefore request the help of two volunteers who attend different Masses, to spend the five necessary minutes "bagging and tagging" the collections. **Please contact the Parish Office to offer your help.**

The reason behind such activity is to verify the honesty of all such financial events, so that Parishioners may understand the methods used to collect, count and bank all income. In general, our collecting and counting teams are permanent and very good. We need to improve the presence of those offering themselves for the "bagging and tagging" so that the overall teamwork is complete. **The second reason behind this verification of all income** is to allow Parishes and

Diocese to apply each year for Revenue Rebates. Magh Ene Parish has been doing this successfully for many years but must add the already mentioned "verification" activity to its present methods, to ensure future rebates will be available. If you can give **FIVE MINUTES** after any Bundoran Mass to this activity, **please contact the Parish Office.**

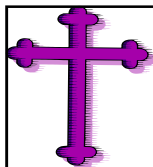
Please support the venture. Available in both Churches.
