Blessing of the Rosary Chapel Windows on August 15th. 2020.

Since all major additions to the Church of Our Lady, Star of the Sea, Bundoran, have historically been announced on the Feast of Our Lady, August 15th. a special week of prayer will precede the presence of Bishop Larry Duffy and hopefully the retired Bishops of Clogher, who will bless and officially recognize the **TWENTY sets** of Windows in the Rosary Chapel, on the coming date of August 15th.

This should be a special spiritual attraction for all who come to Bundoran in days to come.

Weddings / Funerals On the Same Day — Hopefully Not Happening.

Following a discussion with the Pastoral Groups in Bundoran and the Rock, Ballyshannon, the following has been decided. Due to the fact that **the Parish has only ONE full time priest**, wedding times booked into the Parish timetable **will receive priority** and a **Funeral Mass on the same day will begin at 10am**. This is to allow time for the Mass, sympathising, journey to the cemetery and burial. The Priest also needs time to arrive in the Church of the Wedding thirty minutes before that ceremony. The amount of preparation and energy for two such ceremonies on the same morning should also be taken into consideration.

The Diocese of Clogher will soon invite at least ten representatives from **each Parish** of our local cluster to meet with Bishop Duffy, to discuss the future needs of the Diocese and its Parishes. Our meeting will be held on **Wednesday March 11th in Pettigo at 7.30pm.**, with Pettigo, Belleek/Garrison, Irvinestown and Ederney.

First Friday Sacramental Visitation in Bundoran

The new arrangements for the monthly **Visitation of the Sick and Housebound** last week seems to have been successful. Visits will now take place on the first Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons of each month. **Most people were at home in the afternoons** and there was less pressure on the Priest to complete all the calls on one day. This allows the Priest to fulfil his morning work in the Parish Office and complete Sacramental calls in the afternoons. Similar changes in Parish Activity will become the norm in days to come, as the lessening number of available Priests will continue to have an effect on expectations of Parishioners.

The Rock will have it's own arrangements, in relation to Sacramental Visits, with Canon McGourty. Families who wish to have a member added to the visitation list should contact the Parish Priest or Parish Office. Please do not presume that the Priest knows the needs or situation of every Parishioner so do contact him.

Tús Operatives for Future times.

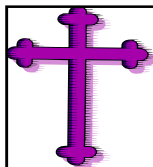
