Ash Wednesday.

Mass will be celebrated in both our Churches next Wednesday to begin the weeks of Lent, in preparation for Easter. **Ashes will be distributed at both Masses,** to allow us indicate our belief in this time of penance and sacrifice in our lives. **The wearing of the ashes is always a personal and missionary activity to others.**

During Lent, we should try to improve our belief in prayer by attending Mass more frequently (where possible) and allocating a few more minutes each day to private prayer. Many might divide the five decades of the Rosary into five different parts of the day, praying for all our special needs. Many might find a few minutes each day to visit the Blessed Sacrament in the Church, to share their personal prayer.

During Lent, we should also try to improve our approach to life by putting to one side what is unnecessary and adding to our lives what is helpful and useful.

Whenever possible, especially with our younger people, we should explain what Lent is really all about - our preparation for Easter by improving as many spiritual and physical aspects of our life as possible.

Due to the severe bolt of lightning which hit Bundoran Church in December, many aspects of normal lighting have been unavailable. It has taken many weeks to assess the damage, find a competent team to repair the damage and negotiate the insurance claim. This has now been accomplished. The Repair Team are presently gathering the necessary units and hope to begin their work on March 9th.(approx.). The repair work should be completed within two weeks, leaving the Church with an even more futuristic system than previously existed. The new webcam camera will hopefully soon again be in operation but do have patience in relation to this..

The overall cost of the operation will be approximately €35,000.
