Pope Francis reminds us that May is the Month of Our Lady and that in these days when most people are confined to their homes, the sharing of the Rosary within our families would be highly recommended. Teaching our younger people how to share each decade and uniting the family in prayer will certainly bless each family in these difficult times.

In Clogher Diocese, **Bishop Duffy and the Priests of the Diocese** are saddened by public Masses, especially Funeral Masses, not taking place, due to the medical problems associated with people being too close together.

Recent Decision by Bishop Duffy in relation to funerals. Families may choose from the following three possibilities.

Burial of deceased as soon as necessary after death. Funeral Mass to take place on a later occasion.

Retention of deceased at home / Funeral Mass on Parish Webcam / Burial after Mass.

Deceased brought to the Church for Funeral Mass with a maximum of **TEN** family members present / **NO** family liturgical activity / Burial after Mass.

In these days, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Baptism and Wedding ceremonies have also been cancelled and cause all of us great disappointment. We await Government decisions in relation to group gatherings before the Diocese can make any future plans. Such activities will certainly have a different nature for some time to come, to ensure the safety of those involved.

Because it is very difficult to anticipate the future, it has been decided to cancel the 2020 **Public Blessing of Graves / Cemeteries.** The Parish Priest will privately bless the cemeteries during a Summer week which will be announced, so that local families may visit and pray for their deceased during that week.

The August 15th. Blessing by Bishop Duffy of the Rosary Chapel Stained Glass Windows in Bundoran has also been cancelled as it is too close to the official opening of Churches in late July and the circumstances which will be associated with such activity will not easily be anticipated.
