Cemetery Planning:

Placing a small 3x3ft grave for ashes beside normal graves would undo the design of the new cemetery areas. Placing the "ashes" graves beside each other would ultimately give the cemetery a better appearance. Undertakers, grave/diggers and families involved will be consulted. Since headstones are not suitable for such small areas, a suitable 3x3flat cover with the necessary information would be sensible – a cover which has a small change in level to allow rain to fall away.

Hymns/ Music at Mass:

The Parish has been complimented by many local and online attendees. The music and hymns we have been using, because our choirs are not available, are very much the old and traditional type of hymn. There are many modern hymns coming from different backgrounds which we might share in the days to come.
