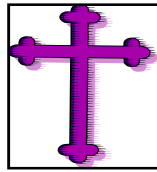
November at 11am Mass for all those from St. Joseph's.

It will be celebrated in each Diocesan Cathedral and in each Parish Church where webcam is available. A candle will be lit in memory of each deceased person and will be available from both sacristies, to use at home during the month of November.
