- 5. Children are dependent on their parents teaching them faith and bringing them to functions in the Church. Many civil & sporting activities NOW take place at the same time as Mass. This was not true in days gone by.
 6. Women were not considered of equal
- standing in the Church in days gone by but that situation is definitely improving.

 7. Would the closure of Churches be dependent on the building or numbers attending. Probably the second idea.
- **8.** What will ultimately happen to Churches, considering the great expense of use and maintenance? Churches attached to cemeteries will always remain in some form of activity.
- **9.** Parish Groups may take over burials in days to come.
- **10.** The Rock Sacristy Group set up the altar table in a wonderful way, for deceased ashes.
- **11.** The Pastoral Group and Sacristy Group attached to St. Joseph's Church were highly complimented for their kindness, support and activity to the Church and the Parish. Was this partially due to the developing knowledge of the lack of a localized Priest?
