Parish Presentation of Funeral Masses.

May they all rest in the peace of Heaven

The main intention of the Funeral Mass is for Priest and Family to pray for the happy repose of the deceased.

The day and time of a Funeral Mass must take into account Parish activity and availability of the local Priest.

The relationship of the deceased person with the Parish is important to know so families are asked to fill in a history document.

Bringing the deceased person to the Church on the evening before the Funeral Mass has been greatly affected by the recent years of Covid, does not happen as often as in previous times but can still take place.

Cremation of a deceased remains has been accepted by the Church. It is presumed that local burial will take place immediately after Mass.

Burial elsewhere must be arranged at the other Parish or Cemetery. Any burial area must either be already owned by the family or arranged at the time of death. There is an Ashes burial section in St. Ninnidh's Cemetery.

In recent years, families have taken part at Funeral Masses in readings, prayers of the faithful, offertory processions and items placed on the funeral table

at the beginning of Mass. The Priest should offer Parish condolences to the family of the deceased. The funeral sermon should be clarification of our faith and preparation in this life for the Lord's invitation to Heaven.

The Priest should complement the association of the deceased person with the Church, their attendance at Masses, their support of Parish faith and local contribution. Hymns at Funeral Masses should involve & contain prayers of faith for this sad occasion – personal non-church musical preferences can be played at the graveside.

Diocesan ruling – eulogies at Funeral Masses are **not allowed** in the Diocese of Clogher.

Family eulogies / music may take place at the graveside as their content may be more personal than of a religious nature. Some national Diocesan opinions have recently suggested that in days to come, due to the unavailability of Clergy, lay prayer-groups may have to present funeral services and burials.

It is certainly something to consider.
