**Graves at St. Ninnidh's Graveyard:**

Lately we have been receiving enquiries about the selling of graves. We would like to respond to these enquiries as follows:

- 1) We no longer sell graves to the living, but

instead, to allocate them to individuals upon their passing.

- 2) To ensure the most efficient and respectful use of our limited burial space, triple graves will no longer be available. We will be offering single and double graves exclusively.

- 3) Double graves will be 6ft wide x 8ft long allowing for two coffins deep so you can have four in total. Single graves will accommodate two coffins.

- 4) Going forward we will only have headstones and no surroundings.

We understand that these changes may require some adjustment, but we believe that they are necessary to ensure the long-term sustainability and proper management of our Parish's burial grounds. We kindly request your understanding and co-operation during this transition.
